## LEADER'S GUIDE


 **Theme:** Comfort


 **Objective:**  
To let students know that God is the ultimate comforter when they're down.

 **Warm Up:**  
Start by allowing the students to pair off in groups of 3. These partners will be their relay race teammates. Line each group up at a starting line (leaving ample room for students to race back and forth) and explain the rules of the relay:

Each team member will be required to race down and back once – the catch is they have to race backwards doing the “crab walk” on their hands and feet. The next team member cannot go until the first team member has crossed the line. The first team to get all 3 members across the finish line first wins.

 **Transition:**  
Play BarlowGirl's “Sing Me a Love Song” while the students are finding their seats. Ask the students to recall a time when they needed someone to pick them up (aside from the race they just completed!). Ask them to share their stories if they feel comfortable. Then, relate a personal story when you needed someone to pick you up. Also, share a time when no one but God was able to comfort you.

 **Bible Study:**  
Read Psalm 34:18, “The Lord is close to the brokenhearted. He rescues those whose spirits are crushed.” God is the true and ultimate comforter. He specializes in broken hearts and crushed spirits. Many times, when you're down, you'll be surrounded by family and friends that are willing to pick you up and dust you off.
